

Maynard Lutheran Church Annual Meeting – January 28, 2024

After a member count, the acting secretary (Laurie Schlenner) announced that there was a quorum present.

President, Rick Groothuis, called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

Pastor Amy Juel led the members in Opening Devotions.

Minutes from the previous annual meeting were read. After confirming there were no corrections or additions, the minutes were approved as read with Lonny Buss making a motion and being seconded by Pam Schulz. All in favor and the motion carried.

The following reports were presented:

Pastor's Report- Pastor Amy presented her report as a page filled with pictures of the events over the past year. Pictures included: The new Blessing Box that has been set up outside of the parish hall. Pastor Amy thanked Lonny Buss and Bruce Bloomquist for their help in the building and placing of the box. The Sunday school students have been re-filling and taking care of the box. She also reminded us to continue to donate items. Linda Dokken will be contacting the Clara City Herald to make people aware of its presence. Pictures of the three students (Rorie, Alexis, and Daniel) signed up for the National Youth Gathering to be held in July. Pictures from the Sunday School Christmas program – both congregation and students. A picture of Pastor Amy & Brother Doug ready for service to begin. A beautiful banner made and given to the church by Pastor Amy's daughter, Julianna. And a few miscellaneous pictures of students and some upcoming events for 2024. Pastor Amy thanked all who have been the "hands and feet of Jesus" in our community, and a special thanks to Holly for her role as administrative assistant.

President's Report – As printed in the Annual Report Packet. President Rick announced that we came up short for our budget and had to withdraw \$25,000 from one of our endowment funds. He expressed hope that donations and attendance would get back to a pre-covid status. Rick also thanked Pastor Amy, the church council, secretary, custodian, and all who keep our church operating.

Treasurer's Report – An annual Profit and Loss Statement was presented to the members present at the annual meeting. A question was asked what church repairs had been done during 2023. Most of the expense was continuing electrical work from 2022 that continued into 2023. The insurance expense was also brought up. President Rick commented that this number will go down as the church needed to purchase a new policy that insures the church for \$850,000 as compared to the previous coverage of \$1,500,000. Rick also pointed out the Thrivent Withdrawal of \$25,000, which consisted mostly of the interest that has been earned.

Worship Team Report – no written report was submitted. Laurie Schlenner commented that the worship team consists of herself, Pam Schulz and Brenda Johnson. The team continues to serve communion and assist Pastor Amy when needed.

Property & Maintenance Report – As printed in the Annual Report packet. Most of the repairs and maintenance were updates required by insurance. Other items included outside lighting repairs and upgrades. No projects or plans other than routine maintenance expected for the upcoming year. Parking lot snow removal will be done by the Bristle family. Pastor Amy will ask Mike Lindblom if he would be willing to do the sidewalks.

Women of the ELCA Report – As printed in the Annual Report packet. The WELCA ladies continue to support the church by serving at funerals and other community events, serving coffee for fellowship after Sunday services, providing cookies for the bank appreciation dinner and other miscellaneous chores around the church.

Other Reports: Financial Secretary's Report showed offerings for 2023 totaling \$110,974.89. Mission Action reported 59 quilts made during the year along with a list of distributions. Altar Guild presented their annual financial statement listing receipts and disbursements. Cemetery Association submitted 2023 financial statement. All details can be found in the Annual Report packet.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the elections. All in favor and the motion carried.

APPROVAL of the 2024 BUDGET – The proposed budget presented was the same as 2023 with three exceptions. Those included an increase in the pastor's salary, secretary's wages, and janitor's wages. Pastor's salary was increased by \$5,000 and wages for the secretary and janitor were increased to \$15.00 an hour. There was no discussion offered by members. A motion was made by Brenda Johnson and seconded by Zach Roelofs to approve the budget as presented. All in favor and the motion was approved.

OLD BUSINESS – There was no old business brought up for discussion.

NEW BUSINESS – Discussion on having some of our younger members help with ushering. The congregation was asked to think about where they would like to donate the noisy offering for 2024. Suggestions were made to keep the donations local or possibly add it to the Pastor's discretionary fund. Members asked, with covid behind us, can we bring back the "passing the peace" during worship? All discussions and suggestions will be prayerfully considered by Pastor Amy and the church council.

ADJOURNMENT – A motion was made by Brenda Johnson and seconded by Zach Roelofs to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the motion carried.

The Lord's Prayer was led by Pastor Amy.
